CEO/Medical Director, Rosenpark Klinik, Darmstadt, Germany. Based on her dermatology background Sonja Sattler is working in Cosmetic/Aesthetic Medicine since 25 years. She is specialized in skin: facial rejuvenation with toxin, filler, EBDs including laser and its best combinations – as well as in general dermatologic surgery. She is also an expert in body rejuvenation including cellulite treatments and vaginal rejuvenation. Dr. Sonja Sattler has more than 20 publications in International Scientific Journals.

After graduation from Medical School in Human Medicine 1993 Dr. Sonja Sattler participated in a 5-year residency program on dermatology and dermatologic surgery. Together with her husband, Dr. Gerhard Sattler she founded 1996 Rosenpark Clinic, Rosenpark Research and BELLARI. Since that time, beside her work as an Aesthetic Physician and Researcher in Dermatology and Aesthetic Dermatology, she has been the guiding hand of the clinic in terms of finances, HR and organizational issues. Until 2018 she was organizing every other year the well-known "International Darmstadt Live Symposium for Dermatologic Surgery and Plastic Surgery" where experts gathered from around the world performing live surgeries. Since 2004 she is the Associate Executive Director of the International Society for Dermatologic Surgery (ISDS). Since many years she loves teaching, giving scientific lectures at national and international congresses, training courses and hands on trainings.

J. Kevin Duplechain, MD, FAACS

Dr. Duplechain is a cosmetic surgeon who practices in Lafayette, Louisiana. He is the current Immediate Past President of the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery (AACS) and of the Cosmetic Surgery Foundation. He is board certified by the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery (ABCS), the American Board of Facial Cosmetic Surgery, the American Board of Facial Plastic Surgery, and the American Board of Otolaryngology/Head and Neck Surgery. Dr. Duplechain's practice focuses on facial and body rejuvenation with a particular focus on facial rejuvenation. He has served on many committees including the emerging trends committee for the AAFPRS, the Young Surgeon's Committee for the American College of Surgeons, and currently, oversees advocacy for the American Academy of Cosmetic Surgery. He has also served on the Executive Committee and the Board of Trustees for the American Board of Cosmetic Surgery. He helped revitalize and serve as the co-director of the AACS pre-conference Cadaver Workshop since 2015. Dr. Duplechain, while serving on the executive committee for the ABCS, developed the "Campaign of 100" -- the ABCS's public awareness campaign -- which has now raised over 1 million dollars on behalf of the ABCS. He has also served as the chairman for the American Society of Cosmetic Laser Surgery and has planned numerous meetings for the AACS including the World Congress of Liposuction in 2019, and the 2020 and 2021 AACS Annual Scientific Meetings. He has also been chosen as one of the Best Doctors in America by his peers for 25 consecutive years. Dr. Duplechain considers serving as the president of the AACS one of the greatest honors of his professional career.

Practical Use of Ultrasound for Safe BBL Surgery & More

There is no better way to enhance your skills in cosmetic surgery than through hands-on practice and one-on-one instruction. This pre-meeting workshop will help participants better understand and implement the use of hand-held ultrasound for a safer Brazilian Butt Lift Surgery as well as other important uses for patient safety in cosmetic surgery.

Modern hand-held ultrasound is fast becoming an indispensable part of the cosmetic surgeon's toolkit when it comes to patient safety. Updated regulations in Florida now require ultrasound-guided visualization when performing the Brazilian Butt Lift procedure, and it is likely that more states and further procedure types will follow.

Through lecture and hands-on practice, attendees will develop a thorough understanding of the value of ultrasound as a modality and improve their competence in use of hand-held ultrasound for Brazilian Butt Lift.

Attendees will learn from the experts and undertake gluteal ultrasound and learn anatomic visualization on live models, as well as practice injection under ultrasound guidance using simulation modalities. All participants qualify for 4 hours of CME and will receive a special certificate for participating in BBL Safety.


